We raised just over £300.00 which was a fantastic amount.

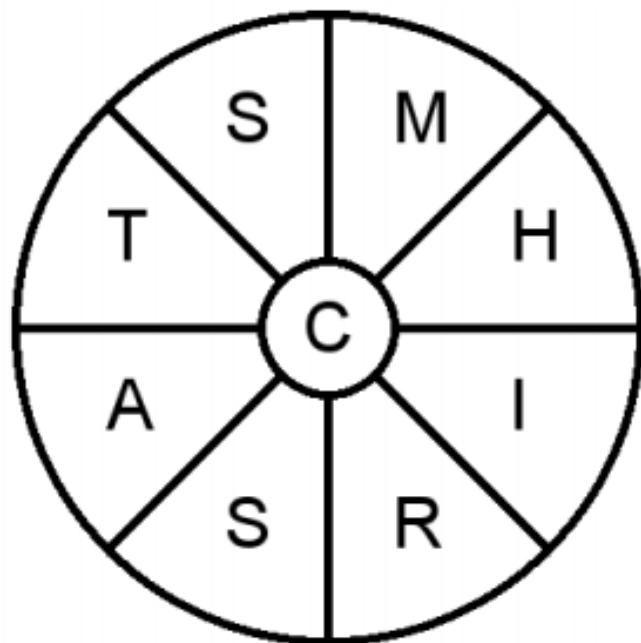
Thank you again for your continued support.
